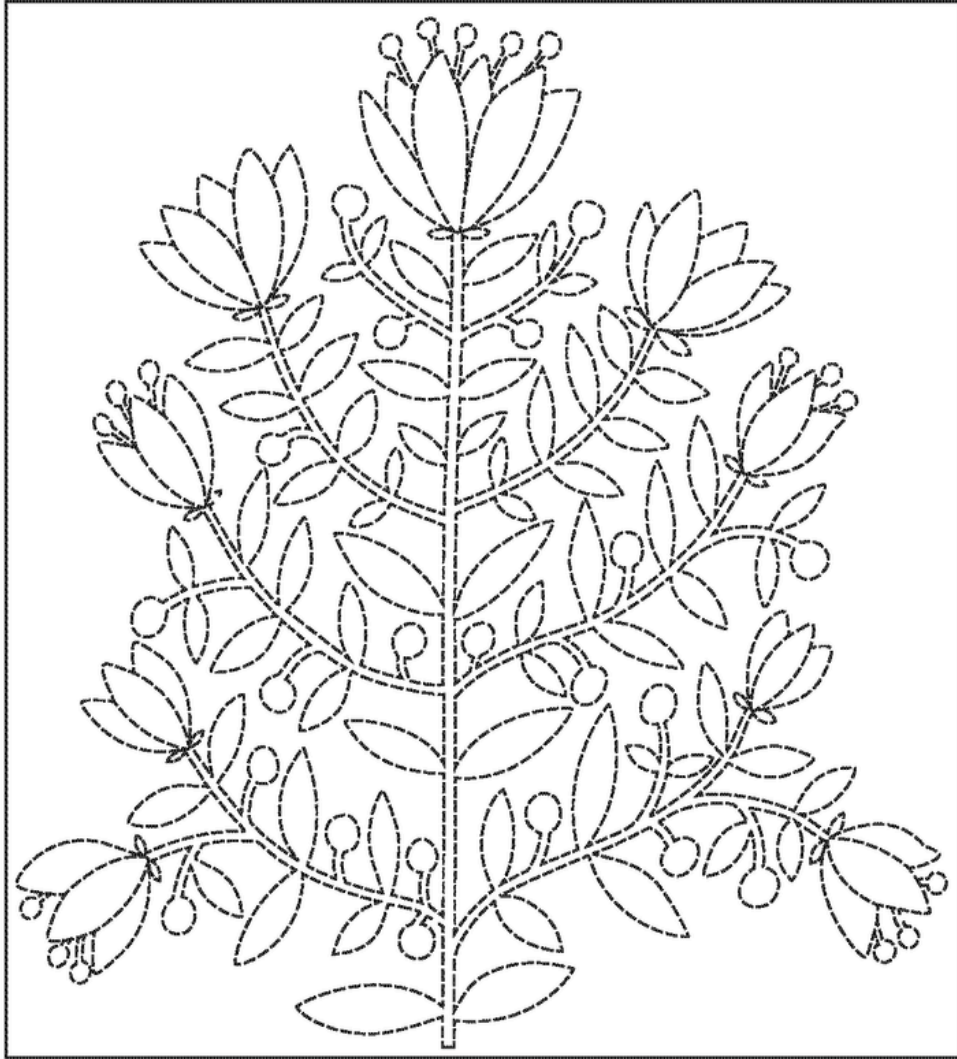

STELLAR EMBROIDERY DESIGN



The Stellar embroidery pattern is inspired by the delicate beauty of 17th-century botanical ornaments and engravings. While inspired by antique sources, it carries my personal interpretation — a quiet dialogue between history and imagination, stitched in thread.

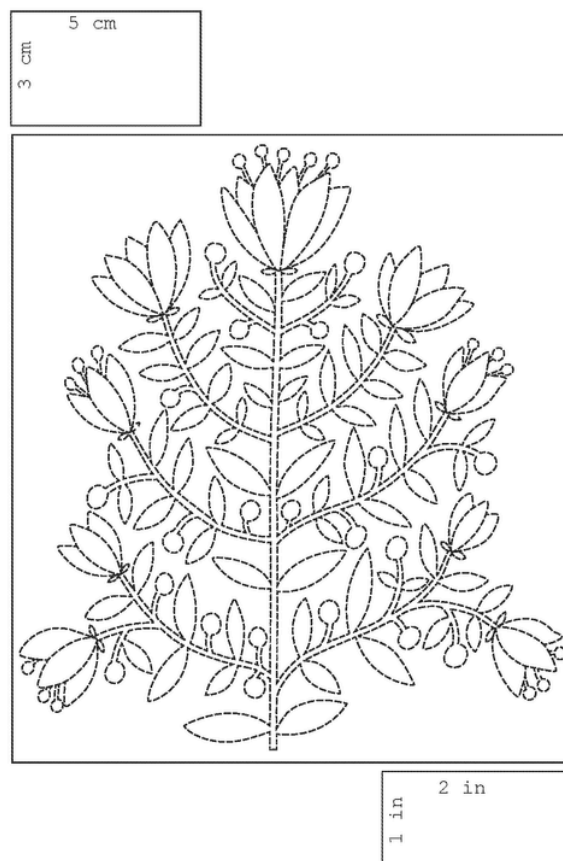
I prefer this embroidery in a single tone, but of course, feel free to let your imagination run wild — change the colours or adjust the shapes to make it your own unique creation.

You can make this embroidery on a ready garment or on a piece of fabric, that will be incorporated in a garment later.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Fabric (woven)
Light- to medium-weight woven fabrics that have some structure and hold its shape, rather than draping loosely (cotton plaid, lawn, chambray, poplin, crisp poplin, seersucker, Linen and linen blends; viscose, lightweight denim; fine Italian style wool.
- Stellar embroidery design (download and print it at actual size)
- Embroidery hoop (20 - 25 cm / 8 - 10 in diameter)
- Embroidery floss in your chosen colours
- Embroidery needle
- Small scissors
- Fabric pen (water- or heat-erasable) or Water (it could be printable) soluble stabiliser or Self-adhesive printable water soluble stabiliser
- Optional: lightbox or sunny window for transferring the design

A4/US Letter Format



The Stellar embroidery design is available for print in Format A4/Us Letter
For best result download the file and open it for printing in Adobe Acrobat Reader.
Make sure that your printer is set to print at 100% (Actual Size).
Print the document in center of paper (Print Centered function or set the Orientation -auto or portrait).
Measure the test square (in centimeters or inches) to ensure that the Calibration is correct.
Alternatively, you can scale the pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Prepare Your Fabric:

Iron your fabric . Place it in the embroidery hoop, pulling the fabric taut like a drum.

2. Transfer the Design:

Use a fabric pen to trace the design onto your fabric. You can do this by placing the printed design underneath the fabric and tracing over it on a lightbox or against a window.

Or you can soluble stabiliser (it can be even printable and self-adhesive).

3. Select Your Threads:

Choose the thread colours you'd like to use. Separate your floss strands if needed (most embroidery floss has 6 strands. The original embroidery is made on a lightweight cotton 110g/sm with 4 floss strands of DCM floss with 6 strands).

4. Start Stitching:

Thread your needle and knot the end. Use the stitch guide below to complete your embroidery:

STEM	BACK STITCH
LEAVES	SATIN STITCH
FLOWER PETTALS	SATIN STITCH
FLOWER STAMENS	FRENCH KNOTS

Tip: Start stitching from the centre of your design and work your way outwards to avoid smudging the lines or bunching the fabric.

5. Finish Off Neatly:

Once finished, tie off your threads securely at the back. Press the embroidery gently from the back side using a pressing cloth.

If using soluble stabiliser, be sure to follow the instructions provided by the manufacturer.

6. Display or Use:

Your embroidery is ready! You can frame it, sew it into a pouch or pillow, or incorporate it into a garment.

STITCH GUIDE :

Back stitch – Great for outlines. Bring the needle up, take a small stitch backward, and bring the needle up a stitch ahead.

Satin stitch – Used for filled areas. Work closely spaced stitches side by side.

French knot – For dots or flower centres. Wrap the thread around the needle and insert it close to where it came up.
